**Workshop Topics:** (Abstract of Scotts description): Making Sense of the Process of Therapeutic Change: What Really Works with the Substance Dependent Client. In this workshop, Scott will separate empirical fact from attention-grabbing fiction, translating 40 years of outcome research into practical therapeutic skills that have been shown to improve the outcome and efficiency of clinical services. Participants will not only learn how to tailor the principles and practices to the individual client, but also how to apply them to the most challenging clinical situations, including work with mandated clients and the co-occurring population. Also participants will learn four research-based factors responsible for client change in treatment and empirically supported counseling / psychotherapy / intervention strategies associated with these factors.
